(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

### WHEREAS:

- C) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MoU for Advancing their mutual interest.

- E) **A.V. Finance** the Second Party is promoted by **Mr. Amit Mehta** near Shivaji Maharaj Statue, Malegaon.
- F) Give related information, its branches, and dimensional information about the Industry concerned with whom the MOU is sworn.

**NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

- 2.9 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
- 2.10 There is no financial commitment on the part of the **K.B.H.S.S.Trust's Dr. B.V. Hiray College of Management & Research Centre, Malegaon**, the First Party to take up any program mentioned in the MOU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

### **CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period **A.V Finance Malegaon**, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MoU. Any act on the part of **A.V. Finance ,Malegaon** , the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MoU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

#### **CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES**

Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.



## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

### BETWEEN

Hiray College of Management & Research Centre, Malegaon** represented herein by its Representative **Dr. Subhash J Jadhav** (hereinafter referred as '**First Party**', the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

### AND

**E-Neuron Technologies, Malegaon**, and represented herein by its Zonal / Divisional Head, **Mr. Mudassar Nazar**, (hereinafter referred to as "**Second Party**", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

### WHEREAS:

- A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:  
**Dr. B.V. Hiray College of Management & Research Centre, Malegaon**
- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.





- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest;.
- E) **E-Neuron Technologies, Malegaon**, the Second Party is engaged in Business, Manufacturing, Skill Development, Education and R&D Services in the fields of *Software Development*.
- F) **E-Neuron Technologies, Malegaon**, the Second Party is promoted by **Mr. Mudassar Nazar** , Malegaon MIDC .
- G) Give related information, its branches, and dimensional information about the industry concerned with which the MOU is sworn.

**NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

#### **CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION**

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

## CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MOU
